With Israeli state militarism and expansionism reaching its peak with a seven-year assault on the West Bank and Gaza and a devastating war on Lebanon, individuals and groups around the world are increasingly joining the campaign for boycott, divestment and sanctions against Israel. Just as it took a world-wide, grassroots movement to topple the Apartheid regime in South Africa, so many are convinced that non-violent economic, political, and cultural pressure on Israel is the only way to bring justice to Palestinians and equality between Palestinians and Jews.

Sami Hermez, who returned to his home of Lebanon just as the Israeli military attacks on that country began, will present an eyewitness account of the War on Lebanon this past summer as well as discuss the Lebanese Call for BDS.

Riham Barghouti and Issa Mikel will give a presentation on the

current campaign for boycott, divestment and sanctions against Israel. They will discuss the arguments for BDS as well as give an overview of some of the strategies involved in launching a BDS campaign. They will also discuss some of the arguments against BDS and present a number of counterarguments.

Sami Hermez is a doctoral candidate of Anthropology at Princeton University currently conducting research on armed and unarmed resistance in Lebanon. He has been in Lebanon since the July 2006 war, where he has been teaching a course on the Anthropology of violence at the American University of Beirut and has been working on relief and redevelopment in the South. He is a founding member of the NYC Campaign for Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions.

Riham Barghouti is a member of the NYC Campaign for BDS, a founding member of the Palestinian Campaign for the Academic and Cultural Boycott of Israel (PACBI), and a founding member of Adalah-NY. She lives and works as a teacher in New York.

Issa Mikel is a member of the NYC Campaign for Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions and a founding member of Adalah-NY. He currently lives and works as an attorney in New York.
